**POSITION TITLE: Emergency Management, up to E-5/SSgt, AFSC: 3E9X1**

**LOCATION OF POSITION: 64<sup>th</sup> Civil Support Team (CST) Rio Rancho New Mexico.**

**AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open to all current members of the New Mexico Air & Army National Guard and those eligible to become members of the New Mexico Air National Guard.**

**NOTE: NM ARMY GUARDMENS must meet eligibility requirements to join the NM Air National Guard prior to appointment if selected for this position.**

**DATE VACANCY EXISTS: currently exist.**

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR AGR TOUR:**

- ❖ **MILITARY COMPATIBILITY:** Individual selected must be assigned, prior to appointment, to a compatible Duty Air Force Specialty Code: 3E9X1.
- ❖ **Also, IAW HQ NMANG Supplement 1 to ANGI 36-101, Chapter 2, Para 2.1.3.3. All other applicants who DO NOT possess the required AFSC and skill level, but meet basic AFSC entry requirements IAW AFM 36-2105 (Officer) and AFM 36-2108 (Enlisted) may be eligible to apply.**
- ❖ **Applicant selected that requires retraining, must meet requirements IAW AFI 36-2201 Volume 3, Attachment 3, Status code (M).**
- ❖ Enlisted member must meet the AFSC requirements outlined in AFMAN 36-2108. Required ASVAB score for **3E9X1 GEN:62**
- ❖ Enlisted member must hold compatible military UMD assignments in the same unit as the position to which assigned. All military personnel policies and instructions apply (ANGI 36-2101)
- ❖ Enlisted member must not have been previously separated from active duty or a previous AGR tour for cause.
- ❖ Must meet the physical examination qualification outlined in Chapter 12, ANGI 36-101, and AFI 48-123 (Medical Examination and Standards).
- ❖ Examination must have been conducted not more than 24 months before entry on AGR duty.
- ❖ Must meet and comply with weight standards at the time of entry into AGR duty.
- ❖ Must be able to acquire 20 years of active duty prior to mandatory separation date (age 60).
- ❖ Must be able to serve at least five (5) consecutive years in the AGR program prior to becoming eligible to receive military non-disability retirement or retainer pay.
- ❖ Must not be eligible for, or receiving an immediate Federal (military or civilian) retirement annuity.

**SPECIAL INFORMATION: As a condition of employment, selected agrees to attend all Unit Training Assemblies and Annual Training deployments, special projects, and exercises when required, with his/her unit of assignment; applicant must be assigned to a Military UMD in the unit they support and UMD compatible AFSC prior to Active Duty Tour. The military uniform will be worn in accordance with AFI 36-2903.**

**NOTE: Technician personnel who are selected for an AGR positions are required to resign from Technician status prior to appointment to the AGR position.**

**NMANG applicants should consult with the 150<sup>th</sup> Retention office prior to accepting an AGR position. Accepting a full-time position may affect incentives. Please contact MSgt Tim Walker @ 846-1370.**

**CLOSING DATE:** Applications will be forwarded to the HRO office, to arrive no later than the end of the business day on the closing date specified on the vacancy announcement.

**SUMMARY OF DUTIES:** Responsible to perform for the duties of NBC Team Chief in the event the NBC Team Chief is not available during a WMD incident. Participates in the state of the art detection and sample collection technology training per the Survey Team training schedule. Expected to be proficient in NBC antidote administration, safe patient extraction, and crime scene/evidence preservation techniques. Participates in/monitors WMD CST chain of custody (sample transfer) procedures. Follows the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) Guide when responding to incidents utilizing the appropriate respiratory protection. Utilizes the established checklist and code words in reporting the detection, identification and sample collection actions in the Hot Zone/contaminated area. Prepares, maintains, and monitors Civil Engineer (CE) operations plans and supporting documents for mobility, response, and recovery operations. Prepares reviews and provides input to installation contingency plans. Monitors prime base engineer emergency force (Prime BEEF), air base operability, hazardous materials emergency response, and disaster preparedness programs, and conducts and schedules associated training. Manages assigned equipment and supplies, performs or schedules equipment maintenance, and inventories assets. Maintains and inspects nuclear, biological, chemical (NBC), and conventional protective clothing and equipment. Conducts NBC and conventional detection, warning, and reporting activities. Maintains and inspects equipment, conducts training, and prepares for peacetime response to use of Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD).
