MEMORANDUM FOR Bargaining Unit Technicians and Supervisors of the New Mexico Army
and Air National Guard

SUBJECT: Uniforms Ready to Wear

1. Through local negotiations between New Mexico National Guard Management and LIUNA Local 1636, it was mutually decided to issue/replace uniforms "ready-to-wear" as follows:

a. Army: Bargaining Unit Personnel will be issued uniforms according to CTA 50-900 and replaced on a fair-wear and tear basis according to AR 700-84, with name-tape, service-tape, and required patches sewn on the uniform. Socks and T-shirts will also be issued and replaced in the same manner under the same regulatory authority. Disposal or cleaning of uniforms or Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) that meet the ignitable, corrosive, or reactive definition as described in the OSHA Hazardous Waste Management Compliance Guide, will be accomplished according to that document.

b. Air: Bargaining Unit Personnel will be issued uniforms on a fair-wear and tear basis according to AFMAN 23-110. Name-tape, service-tape, rank, and required patches will be sewn on two (2) uniforms of the bargaining unit members choice, per fiscal year, on a one for one replacement basis.

2. Supply organizations will be encouraged to requisition uniforms within 48 to 72 hours whenever possible. Requisition documentation will be made available to bargaining unit technicians upon request.
